

**Emergency Preparedness/Evacuation Plan
August 2019

Recent rain has brought with it a great deal of lightning. You may have heard the Rap Attack helicopter circling and landing in Hupple, July 23rd. A local resident called in a report after seeing a lightning strike and smoke west of Cooke Creek. The Rap Attack crew waited on the south side of the river anticipating that the morning uphill wind would perhaps get the fire burning again. This ended up being just a "smoke chase". Often a lightning strike will cause a fire, which will appear to be extinguished with accompanying rain - only to start burning several days later. If you see a lightning strike, keep a close eye on the location. Be sure to report it, if you see smoke-which is usually white and billowing. The Fire Center tracks the location of all lightning strikes, but still largely depends on visual reports of smoke. The number to call is **1-800-663-5555** or ***5555** on a cell phone.

I requested an update from the Regional District staff as to the revision of the 2005 Evacuation Plan. The Provincial Government recently provided funding for the Regional District to conduct the revision. At the time of this writing, I have not been given an update.

For up to date information about current restrictions and the locations of active fires, go to the BC Wildfire Service website. There are several ways to get to the site. I use: bcwildfire.ca

The news is full of information about increased floods and fires as a result of Climate Change. Young people and millennials are getting involved and active. Consider making Climate Change an issue in the upcoming election.
